The following non-prescription medicines may be stocked in the camp health center and are used on an as-needed basis to manage minor illness and injury. **If you approve the use of any or all medications listed below, please check the ones you allow, sign below and have a doctor sign and date the form.** All medications are given based on your child's weight or age as listed on the instructions. Please fill out one form per camper.

- Acetaminophen (Tylenol)
- Ibuprofen (Motrin/Advil)
- Anti-itch lotion
- Anti-histamine/allergy medication (Benadryl/Claritin)
- Antibiotic ointment (Neosporin)
- Anti-diarrheal (Imodium)
- Antacid (Tums)
- Hydrocortisone cream
- Bug Spray (Contains DEET)
- Sunscreen (up to SPF 30)
- Sunburn lotion (Aloe or after sun)
- Generic cough drops
- Cough syrup (Robitussin)
- Sore throat spray
